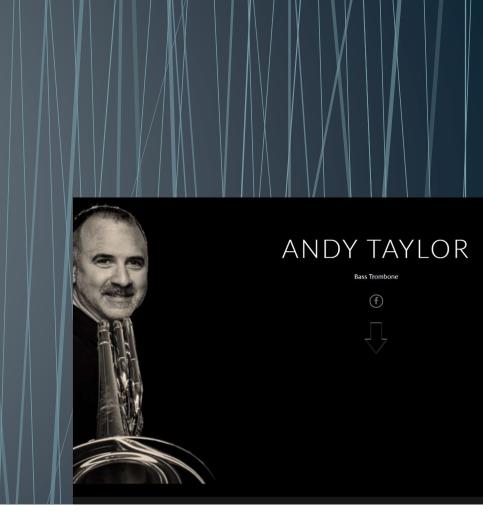

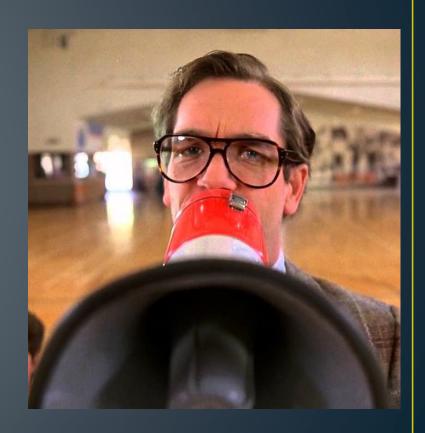

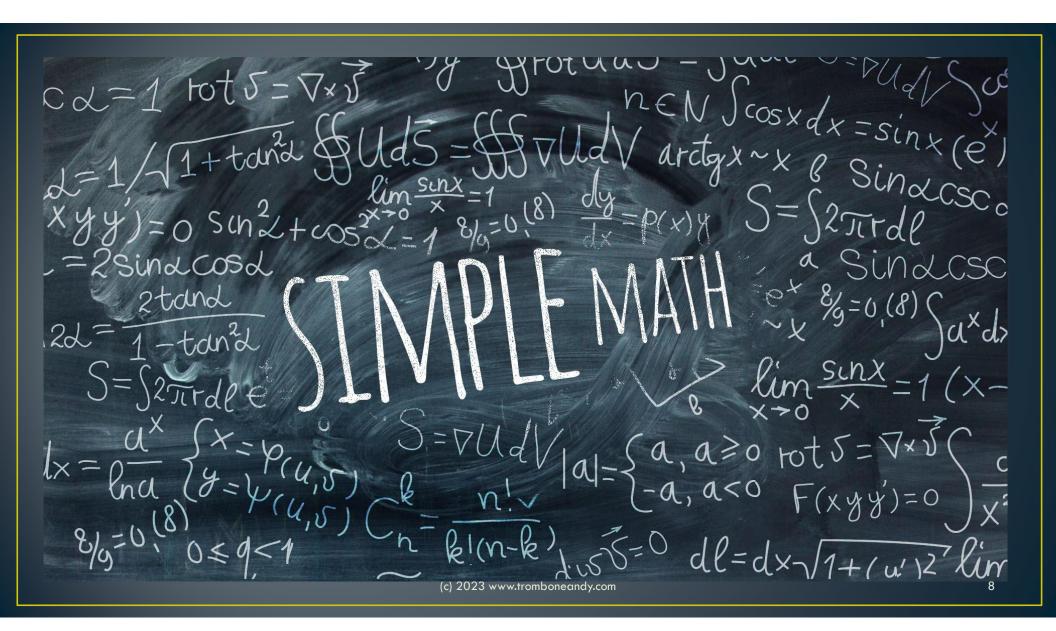


ChatGPT - How can I find a gig?

- 7. Have a polished ad professional demo or recording of your performances



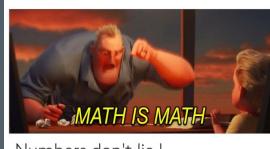

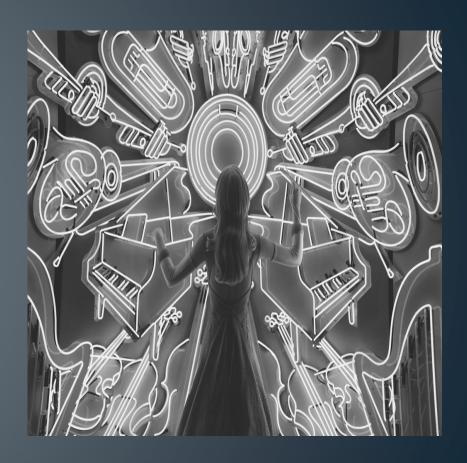
- Be findable: URL, social media, biz card, e-press

 - China
 - International Trombone Festival
 - All Classical Thursdays at Three



Techniques To Get The Gig



- GETTING STARTED VS. GROWING
- PLAN GIG HUNTING TIME EVERY DAY. STRATEGIES:
 - VOLUNTEER
 - CALL TILL YOU HAVE 3 NO'S
 - CHECK YOUR CALENDAR FROM LAST YEAR
 - CHECK THE LEAD SHEETS FROM PAST GIGS
 - SCAN FACEBOOK EVENTS, WILLAMETTE WEEK, ALL CLASSICAL FM
 - ASK A FRIEND
- SEND A SAMPLE "TAPE"/LINK

You will not get 100% of whatever you don't ask for.





How To Keep The Gig

- HAVE A GREAT SHOW
- BE PROFESSIONAL FIRST IMPRESSIONS BEHAVIOR LOSES REPEAT GIGS
- ASSUME THE MIC IS ALWAYS ON
- ETHICS WHAT YOU DO WHEN NO ONE IS LOOKING



- MAKE IT EASY FOR THE BOOKING AGENT
- PROMOTE YOUR HOSTS' BUSINESS
- FOLLOW UP WHEN THEY TELL YOU TO
- MAKE REQUESTED ADJUSTMENTS (PLAY THEIR FAVORITE SONG)



- KNOW HOW YOU'RE GETTING PAID
- MARKETING & MERCH

Every performance is an audition for some next gig



Spreadsheets & Calendars & Contracts -- oh my!

Breakout session - your plan

- Ideal venue: bar, schnitz, concert hall, living room, outdoors
- Possible gigs for this group: ongoing vs. seasonal
- Social media
- Notes: funding source?



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
